## What's going on with Homer Electric Association (HEA):

Voting for the <u>Board of Director elections</u> is open until HEA's Annual Meeting on **May 2nd**. As members, one of the biggest tools we have in our toolbox is who we vote for to represent us on the Board of Directors. Our electric utility is governed by a democratically elected Board who is beholden to members and our community - you! You can learn more about this year's candidates here.

KDLL, KBBI, the Peninsula Clarion, and the League of Women Voters hosted a candidate forum at the Soldotna Public Library last month - read about it <u>here</u>. We were excited to hear talk of diversification of generation, energy conservation, and energy independence.

As of April 1st, HEA's natural gas contract with Hilcorp has ended, and a new one-year contract with Enstar has started. Note the natural gas will be at Enstar's Gas Cost Adjustment (currently \$8.6517, compared to the previous contracted Hilcorp rate of \$7.69). We should see more of the financial impact with the next Cost of Power Adjustment (COPA) filing - info on the current COPA filing here.

The next HEA Board meeting is April 9th.

## What's going on in Alaska:

At a recent Golden Valley Electric Association Board meeting, CEO John Burns "<u>acknowledged</u> that the cause of the [rate] increase is the fact that GVEA hasn't diversified our energy production enough."

## What we can do:
